

# Pack 700 Uniform Guide

*All new Pack 700 members must purchase their rank book and uniform*

## **Field Dress (Class A) vs. Activity (Class B)**

Field Dress (Class A) requires the scout shirt, scarf, belt and dark blue jeans or shorts. Hat is optional. Field dress is worn to all den and pack meetings, field trips and parades.

**All appropriate badges and patches to be sewn in the correct manner.** Proper placement of all items can be viewed on the uniform page of the Pack 700 website.

Activity (Class B) requires a scouting t-shirt and blue jeans or blue jean shorts. Shorts should be a dark blue jean material or a solid dress blue material. No basketball, cut-off or camo shorts. Activity (Class B) is worn at camp, on campouts, or when an activity may damage the Field Dress (Class A) uniform.

Casual or tennis shoes may be worn. Sandals are worn only as permitted. Hiking boots are not needed. **Heeley's are not permitted at anytime.**

## **Tiger Cubs**

Field Dress (Class A) includes the blue Cub Scout Shirt, Belt, orange scarf with slide, the Tiger Cub hat and Rank Totem. Pack 700 will supply the totem. Proper placement of all items can be viewed on the uniform page of the Pack 700 website.

## **Wolf and Bear Cubs**

Field Dress (Class A) includes the blue Cub Scout shirt, belt, patches, scarf with slide and hat. Wolf Cubs wear the yellow scarf and hat. Bear Cubs wear the blue scarf and hat.

Required patches purchased by parents are as follows: Blue Ridge Council Patch, Den number and the World Crest. Belt Loops and Special event patches are also purchased by the parent.

Pack 700 provides the Quality Unit patch, Pack Numerals, and all earned patches. Proper placement of all items can be viewed on the uniform page of the Pack 700 website.

## **Webelos Scouts**

Field Dress (Class A) includes the blue or tan Scout shirt, patches, belt, plaid scarf with slide and optional plaid hat.

Required patches purchased by parents are as follows: Blue Ridge Council Patch, Den number and the World Crest. Belt Loops and Special event patches are also purchased by the parent.

Pack 700 provides the Quality Unit patch, Pack Numerals, and all earned patches. Proper placement of all items can be viewed on the uniform page of the Pack 700 website.

## **Graduation Gifts to Cub Scout**

Pack 700 holds its annual graduation Ceremonies in the spring. At this time each Cub Scout is given his next rank book and neckerchief with slide. Shirts are not provided by Pack 700.
